THE CATHOLIC NETHERLANDS, whose Greatest Part is Possessed by the House of Austria, as the full Colouring shows it, consist of Ten Provinces, which are 1. the Dutchy of Brabant, a portion of which belongs to the Dutch, with the Austrian Brabant, as incorporated in the Margravate of the Holy Roman Empire, including the City of Antwerp or Amers, and its Territory; 2. the Lordship of Mecheln or Malines, in Austria; 3. the Dutchy of Gelders, divided into Austrian, Dutch, and Prussian, or Upper Gelders; 4. the Dutchy of Limburg, divided also into Austrian and Dutch; 5. the Dutchy of Luxemburg is Austria, but of which the French possess the whole Southern Frontier, which they name Lorraine Allenee; 6. the County of Namur, divided into Austrian, French, and Dutch Flanders; the Tournaise, a Part of the Austrian Flanders; 7. the County of Namur, or the Namurois, in Austria, except a few Districts towards the South, which belong to the French; 8. the County of Haynam, divided between Austria and France; 9. the County of Artes, in France; 10. the Cambresis, in France.

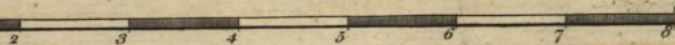
