- 2. THE LORDSHIP OF MECHLIN, to Austria.
- 3. THE DUTCHY OF LIMBURG, divided into Austrian and Dutch.
- 4. GELDERLAND, or DUTCHY OF GELDERS, divided into Austrian, Prussian and Dutch.
- 5. THE DUTCHY OF LUXEMBURG, of which the French possess a small Share.
- 6. THE COUNTY OF FLANDERS, belonging to the Austrian, French and Dutch.
- 7. NAMUROIS, or COUNTY OF NAMUR, of which the French possess a small Share.
- 8. COUNTY OF HAINAUT, divided between France and Austria.
- 9. COUNTY OF ARTOIS, and 10. CAMBRESIS, to France.
